Congregation Meeting Updates. On June 22, a Congregational Meeting was held. This meeting is one of two annual meetings mandated by our constitution and bylaws. In January each year, we meet to formally and publicly review our ministry from the last year and look ahead at the next year's plans. In June, we meet to approve our annual Ministry Financial Plan as well as to elect open Coordinating Council positions. At the June 22 meeting, the MFP was unanimously approved. This MFP was very similar to last year's and did take into account our upcoming faculty changes as well as an anticipated enrollment of 65 students in our school. Praise be to God for allowing us to continue to have the resources to operate the ministries we do here at St. Mark's.
